It is hard to believe that we are already in the year 2024, and hopefully this shipment will come as welcome relief to those who made the bold move of having a dry January! The collection of Pinot Noirs in this release represents some of our favorite growers—who, much like the vineyards themselves—have quite different personalities. The Francioni, Pisoni, Parsons and Dutton families all express their home terroirs with focus and pride. Add into the mix some gorgeous sites from Anderson Valley and Sta. Rita Hills, and we have a beautiful spectrum of the possibilities of Pinot Noir along the West Coast. The wine notes included tell a small part of the story, but I’m excited for you to open the bottles and taste for yourselves!

This being your first look at the 2022 vintage, I think you will like what you see quite a bit. The wines are ripe and ready, with a fruit forward deliciousness factor that is easy to love. The vintage was a warmer one but owing to the lessons of vintages like 2017 with similar heat events, we were able to bring in fruit from up and down the coast while it still had freshness—and it’s evident in the bottle and in the glass. The common thread among the 2022 Pinot Noirs is their distinct juiciness, and they’re ready to be enjoyed right out of the gate.

As always, we are incredibly grateful for your support, and we hope you are enjoying the wines as we look to make better and better Pinot Noirs each vintage. I’ve always said that if you have as much fun drinking the wines as we do making them, we’ve done our job. With that, let us raise a glass to the release of the 2022 vintage—I hope we can open a bottle of Siduri together soon!

2022 DUTTON-PERRY RANCH VINEYARD PINOT NOIR RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Rich, layered and vibrant, the 2022 Dutton-Perry Ranch showcases the cool, bucolic hills of Green Valley of Russian River Valley in delicious fashion. The final blend consists of equal parts Dijon 114, 777 and Mt. Eden clones. Clone 777 shows soaring red fruits and floral notes, while clone 114—which I think is the star of the vineyard—explodes with black cherry and the signature cola notes of Green Valley. Clone 37, which is a new addition for us in the vineyard, provides black raspberry and ample richness—laying the foundation for the finish that glides along effortlessly. Formerly known as Keefer, and still Siduri’s longest tenured Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, the Dutton family—which is now six generations deep in Green Valley farming—coaxes the most of this beautiful site.

2022 ROSELLA’S VINEYARD PINOT NOIR SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS

Lying smack-dab in the sweet spot of the middle of the Santa Lucia Highlands, Rosella’s always makes a strong case for the wine of the vintage or us at Siduri. Buffered from heat waves by the omnipresent coastal gusts from the adjacent Monterey Bay, Rosella’s offers up a classic blueberry-tinged fruit profile, with hints of blackberry, rose and anise. Equal parts 115 and 828 with just a splash of 777, which create a blend that is sleek and refined, yet with ample weight and richness. The balance of Rosella’s vineyard always translates directly into the glass. The Francioni family has an attention to detail that is hard to match—and this being Gary’s home turf, the vineyard is always dialed-in just right. Thank you, Francioni family for another beautiful vintage of Rosella’s Vineyard!

2022 EDMEADES VINEYARD PINOT NOIR ANDERSON VALLEY

Just a stone’s throw from where it all began for Siduri back in 1994 lies the Edmeades Vineyard, nestled atop a hillside in the “Poleeko” neighborhood of Anderson Valley. The huge diurnal swings in this area of Anderson Valley provide fresh, crunchy fruit and soaring aromatics. Clone 667 displays fresh strawberry, violets, and pennyroyal on a solid frame with ample polished tannins. The Calera clone—which sets a relatively juicy cluster—provides fresh cherry and rose petal, with an undercurrent of acid that blends seamlessly with the 667 clone. Weighty through the midpalate yet elegant, the 2022 Edmeades Vineyard Pinot Noir is set up for a long life in the cellar.

2022 PERILUNE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR STA. RITA HILLS

The steepest vineyard section in the entire Siduri lineup is the foundation of the 2022 Perilune Vineyard Pinot Noir. Planted straight down a steep hillside in fractured clay loam soils, clone 114 is the star of the blend and a harrowing adventure to farm! Highly aromatic, with red and dark fruit, spice, and dried flowers, Perilune’s fruit is well worth the difficulty farming. Clone 828 from a (thankfully!) flat, sandy section of the vineyard provides structure and dark fruit due to the clone’s thicker skins. It has been a joy to watch this vineyard grow up, and the sky is the limit for the potential of this incredible site.

2022 SOBERANES VINEYARD PINOT NOIR SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS

Soberanes, a joint venture between two of our favorite farming families—the Francionis and the Pisonis, had another stellar year as this vineyard continues to impress us. Dark fruited and concentrated, with accents of black tea and earth, we used about 20% whole cluster in the final blend for an extra dimension of high-toned fruit and structure. The rocky, gravelly soils are evident, as the wine has ample yet soft tannins that guide the flavors through the finish. Directly adjacent to Garys’ vineyard, Soberanes shares a great deal of common traits with its’ older brother. Well done, Pisoni and Francioni families!

2022 PARSONS’ VINEYARD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Kelley and Tom Parsons, two of the most effusively nice grape growers you will ever meet, farm this small 8-acre Pinot Noir Vineyard on the Santa Rosa Plains in the heart of the Russian River Valley. Kelley does a good deal of the handwork herself, while Tom helps with tractor work and fixing trellis wires. This hands-on mentality, aided by long-time vineyard manager Jim Pratt, form a dream-team of small growers. The wines, of course, reflect this in a sense of place that remains difficult to match no matter how many vineyards we kick the dirt in. Black cherry, sage, turned earth and cola emerge from the glass effortlessly, and carry the midpalate richness that just oozes Russian River Valley. Length, weight, richness, and focus are all highlights of this wine simultaneously, and we are lucky to have the Parsons family as partners to provide this beautiful Pinot Noir.



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
