### 2022 SIERRA MAR VINEYARD SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS

Perched high on a windy, sandy, rocky outcropping in the Southern end of the Santa Lucia Highlands, Sierra Mar produced a lively, dark fruited Pinot Noir in 2022. An intriguing clonal mix of 23, 777 and Pisoni Selection make for a Pinot Noir scented with black plum, licorice, and sandalwood. Once sipped, flavors of black cherry, blackberry paste, and mocha carry through the finish—a Pinot Noir that is equally dark fruited, yet light on its feet.

### 2022 ZENA CROWN VINEYARD EOLA-AMITY HILLS

Positioned on a southwest-facing slope of weathered volcanic soils in the Eola-Amity Hills of the Willamette Valley, Zena Crown Vineyard benefits from well-drained soils and the ever-present winds pulled in from the Pacific Ocean via the Van Duzer Corridor. Buffered by these coastal winds, Zena Crown avoided a devastating spring frost and then benefitted from the warmest October on record in the Willamette Valley. The resulting wine is explosively aromatic, with raspberry, lilac and orange peel jumping out of the glass, buttressed by black cherry, allspice, and sarsaparilla on the lively and complex palate.

### 2022 VAN DER KAMP VINEYARD SONOMA MOUNTAIN

There is good reason that the Van der Kamp Vineyard maintains its place as the longest-standing single vineyard wine in the Siduri lineup—there simply is not a vineyard, or place, quite like it. The Van der Kamp family takes great care to promote healthy vines on their home ranch, with the mountain terrain producing wines that are both graceful and powerful. Clones 23, 777, 828 and Martini weave together to create a Pinot Noir with black tea, cremini mushroom and bright cherry on the nose, with a palate saturated with flavors of blackberry, anise, and cardamom.

### 2022 SKYCREST VINEYARD ANDERSON VALLEY

Anderson Valley benefitted from its typical cool start to the season, which delayed ripeness until late in the harvest. The warm conditions in early September that affected the other growing areas in the state occurred long before any Pinot Noir in Anderson Valley was ripe enough to consider picking. Skycrest, with its burly mountain personality at 1,800 feet above the valley, shines with blackberry, plum and clove aromatics, and once sipped, flavors of black cherry, bing cherry, and cola meet with a pliant tannic structure that hold the flavors through a gracefully long finish.

### 2022 SEALIFT VINEYARD SONOMA COAST

The remoteness of the Sealift Vineyard is always well worth the trip—and undeniably well worth what Pinot Noirs it produces. Perched on a ridge near the far-coastal town of Annapolis on Goldridge Sandy Loam soils, Sealift is simultaneously dark and brooding, yet lively aromatically—a wonderful combination that our entire team fell in love with immediately. The 2022’s scents of the typical Annapolis orange peel, dark fruits and earth join an extraordinarily rich palate with flavors of black figs, truffle, and ginger.

### 2022 GARYS’ VINEYARD SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS

The 2022 growing season in Garys’ Vineyard began with a slightly later than usual bud break, with a bloom period that was warm and dry, which promoted even fruit set. The “main event,” was a prolonged heat wave that began on Labor Day Weekend and lasted for several days. However, the cooling effect of the deep waters of the adjacent Monterey Bay allowed the fruit to chill, promoting freshness and balance. Dark cherry, raspberry and violets lead the way on the aromatic profile, with the palate bursting with blackberry pie, licorice, and cracked pepper.
