Tasting Notes

2018 Gran Moraine Vineyard Pinot Noir

Willamette Valley

Black cherry, blackberry and star anise jump from the glass in this outstanding offering from Yamhill-Carlton in Willamette Valley. One of the finest vintages in recent memory in the Willamette Valley, this wine is certainly one of the most age-worthy offerings Siduri produced in 2018. The wine is very dark, with taut, fine-grained tannins and brisk acidity. Produced from the sun-drenched upper sections of the Gran Moraine vineyard, this is a wine that I can't wait to open for dinner tonight and will enjoy revisiting for well over a decade.

2018 Edmeades Vineyard Pinot Noir

Anderson Valley

The 2018 Edmeades vineyard shows crunchy red and black fruits in spades. The huge diurnal temperature swings of this Anderson Valley site allow for the full spectrum of red/blue/black fruit. Additionally, a textural sweetness on the entry leads to pleasantly grippy tannins though the midpalate which highlight the tart cherry notes through the finish. The acidity of this Pinot Noir provides a finesse and energy that holds the purity of the fruit and delicate oak flavors at great length. We are thrilled to be making vineyard designate wines from the Anderson Valley and there is no place we would rather be than this historic site.

2018 Perry Ranch Vineyard Pinot Noir

Russian River Valley

Raspberry and sous bois notes on the nose open to bright Bing cherry with time in the glass. Finely textured throughout as a result of judicious use of whole-cluster fermentations and the succulent acidity of this Green Valley site, this Pinot Noir has the aromatic pop and structure to either drink now or age for well over a decade. Tasting from the same bottle the next day, the Perry Ranch offers secondary mushroom notes that are interwoven with the primary fruit throughout the palate and the long, lingering finish. A beautiful wine from a remarkable site in a great vintage – it's a joy to share this wine!

2018 Barbieri Vineyard Pinot Noir

Russian River Valley

Dark and decadent, the 2018 Barbieri Vineyard Pinot Noir jumps from the glass with dried cherry accented by candied plum and mushroom notes. The burst of fruit is anchored by a weighty midpalate that glides through the finish on fine-grained tannins and racy acidity. One of our favorites for bringing that stereotypical Russian River Valley fruit profile with a heavyweight swagger, the 2018 impresses now and will benefit from mellowing out in the cellar for a few years.

2018 Soberanes Vineyard Pinot Noir- Add on

Santa Lucia Highlands

The 2018 vintage was very kind to Soberanes – complex aromas of maraschino cherry and rose petal are framed delicately by accents of toasty oak. The rich, juicy entry of the palate showcases the bright fruit notes, with zesty acidity focusing the flavors through the long, succulent finish. This is one of the better vintages of Soberanes that we have made at Siduri and highlights the wonderful 2018 vintage. This wine will benefit from a year or two in bottle but is irresistible now!

2018 Sierra Mar Vineyard Pinot Noir – Add on

Santa Lucia Highlands

The 2018 Sierra Mar Pinot Noir showcases black raspberry, fig and sandalwood aromatics that lead to a creamy midpalate offering loads of bramble fruit and hints of caramel. One of our southernmost sites in the Santa Lucia Highlands, this wine offers a beautiful mix of fruit, creaminess and backbone through the lengthy finish that are indicative of the sky-high quality of the 2018 vintage. I'm excited to revisit this wine every few months to see how it grows up, because it is wonderful now at such a young age.

2018 Rosella's Vineyard Pinot Noir

Santa Lucia Highlands

Wonderfully high-toned and pure on the nose, the 2018 Rosellas displays bright cherry, macerated strawberry, pomegranate and subtle hints of sage. The delicate mouthfeel of the wine has a seamless interplay of tannin and acid, holding the bright fruit notes through the finish. A wine that has the signature Rosella's notes of graceful tannins and racy acidity, this is a Pinot Noir that showcases the windswept northern Santa Lucia Highlands and meticulous viticulture that makes the fruit shine so brightly. The brightness of this wine is incredibly difficult to resist.

2018 John Sebastiano Vineyard Pinot Noir

Sta Rita Hills

Effusive blackberry and blueberry jam aromatics are complemented by toffee and forest floor notes in this not-so-shy wine. Seductively juicy and rich on the palate, the bramble fruits are tightly wound by brisk acidity and lush tannins. Amazingly full bodied for a modest alcohol of 14.2%, it's very tempting to put too fine a point on it – this Pinot Noir is just pure deliciousness. This low-vigor site allows for extended maturation on the vine in the cool Santa Rita Hills, and 2018 allowed us to push ripeness without high sugars or losing acidity – the results in the glass are very satisfying.
