2021 PINOT NOIR VAN DER KAMP VINEYARD

WINEMAKING NOTES

Always a fun (yet challenging) puzzle to put totgether, the Van der Kamp vineyard offered up some very distinctive blend pieces from this gorgeous Sonoma Moutnain estate in 2021. The clone 23 from the very top of the mountain serves as the backbone, which is rounded out by the 828 and Martini from the heart of the vineyard. Finally, the 777 clone from the bottom adds finesse and beautiful dried herb undertones to this lively Pinot Noir. Cheers!
