2021 PINOT NOIR RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

The Siduri Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is sourced from a diverse array of sub-AVAs and neighborhoods that are harmoniously layered into a singular expression of this exceptional place to grow Pinot Noir. The Green Valley AVA, as well as the neighborhoods of The Laguna, Santa Rosa Plains and Sebastopol Hills are brought together to showcase the classic dark cherry and cola notes that Russian River Valley Pinot Noirs exhibit in spades.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2021 growing season in the Russian River Valley was marked by a relatively cool spring and mid-summer, with heat picking up towards the finish line of harvest. The lighter than average crop accelerated ripening, leading to an early and compact harvest season during the first half of September. Vintners around the Russian River Valley were rewarded for the hurried harvest season with outstanding, intense flavors, dark colors and soft tannins.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Each vineyard section was vinified separately, with some whole-cluster fermentations on sections with more lignified stems - typically on the Pommard clone. The 2021 vintage provided tremendous freshness and ample acidity - a vintage that will age beautifully.
